Training and Exercise Plans

- » Best way to budget for training and exercise programs
- » Multi-Year Training and Exercise Plan (MYTEP)
 - Local or Regional document detailing
 - Best practices, capability gaps, key priorities
 - 3-year training and exercise schedule
- » Training and Exercise Planning Workshop (TEPW)
 - Workshop to help create your MYTEP
 - DEMA Training and Exercise staff can assist you with a TEPW and MYTEP
- » **Funding requests should support MYTEP activities**



MYTEP and Grant Planning

- » Consider what areas you want to focus on:
 - THIRA and State Preparedness Report
 - Core capabilities
 - Gaps identified during exercises or events
- » Reference or update your existing MYTEP; OR
- » Create a local/regional MYTEP
- » Plan at least a year's worth of training and exercise programs
- » Coordinate regionally to request grant funding
